Procedures for Nominations for the GT Program

Please understand that referrals are accepted from teachers, school personnel, parents, students, and community members. The coordinator can also use the review of student assessment scores to refer students, along with the data retrieved from enrichment. Although the district sets specific for requesting referrals, specifically March and April, referrals are encouraged and accepted at all times during the school year. It is the responsibility of the gifted coordinator to seek these referrals and to begin the identification process in a timely manner. A referral form is completed on each individual and submitted to the gifted coordinator. Referral forms can be obtained from the gifted coordinator.

While referrals are accepted at any time and every effort will be made to begin the testing process, please understand that most of the testing will happen in April and May and that the selection committee meets in early September.
