

- All dry erase markers will write legibly on a Claridge porcelain markerboard, but not all will erase properly due to their composition. We recommend the use of dry-erase markers supplied through Claridge as stringent testing procedures are in place to ensure both ease of writing and quality of erasing. Low odor markers, which are water based, do not perform as well due to the increased drying time and the more intense bond between the ink and the surface. Use of low odor markers will lead to “ghosting” even with proper cleaning.
- If you use your board daily, we recommend that you clean the surface at least twice per week. In addition, it is important to know that leaving ink on the board for an extended period of time can lead to “ghosting”. We recommend that you erase your board on a regular basis.
