

### Ways to get your Offer Accepted in a Seller's Market

- Offer above the asking price. In a seller's market, there may be multiple offers on the home of your dreams.
- Offer a large earnest money deposit. Show the seller that you are serious and a good-faith buyer.
- **Make sure that your offer is complete.** Missing documentation in a competitive market may get your offer overlooked.
- Make your offer as clean as possible. Exclude contingencies on the sell of your home, financial constraints, and closing cost shares.
- **Don't ask for personal property.** Skip asking for exclusion items or adding furniture pieces.
- Submit your preapproval letter and proof of funds. Match your preapproval letter to your sales price and date it the same day as your offer.





### How to Sell your home in the Spring Market

- Spring Clean. Wash windows, mirrors, light fixtures, walls, drapes/curtains, blinds, bathrooms, and bedding. Also, polish the floors and shampoo the carpets/rugs.
- **Utilize accessories.** Use throw pillows, towels, and throws in bright spring colors to liven up the atmosphere of your home. Also, set your table and include a center piece.
- **Fragrances.** You cannot go wrong with a good smelling home. Make use of plug in room fragrances or fill rooms with fresh, fragrant flowers.
- Yard maintenance. Rake the yard, mow the grass in a diagonal pattern, trim the bushes or overhanging tree limbs, plant flowers or use flowers in pots & planters.
- **Power wash.** Sidewalks, sides of homes, decks, outside furniture, and outbuildings.
