



Buyer: How to Successfully Work With a Realtor

Once you have chosen an experienced Realtor®, some information and guidelines that will help you have a mutually successful relationship are listed below.

- **Sign an Agency Representation Disclosure**. This will establish the business relationship between you, the agent, and the brokerage.
- **Provide a list of expectations.** This helps your agent find the homes that best suit your needs.
- **Keep appointments and arrive on-time.** Most showings must be scheduled, and the agent is opening their schedule to accommodate you.
- Allow your agent to make all showing appointments. Do not contact listing agents on your own as doing so may create a conflict of interest.
- **Be ready to buy when the right opportunity presents itself.** If you're not ready, another offer may be presented and accepted before your agent has the opportunity to write an offer.
- Only sign forms that you understand. If you do not understand a document, ask questions until you do.
- Remember that agents are commission-based only; they do not make any profit until there is a closing on a home. All time and travel involved in investing in you is out of their own pocket.
