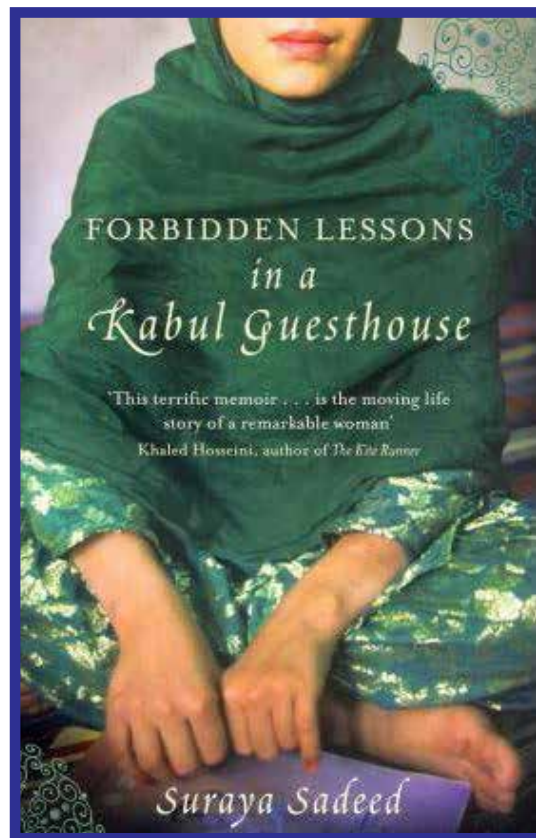

Men 65 and over will play gold tees, men 64 and younger will play white tees, and ladies will play red tees.

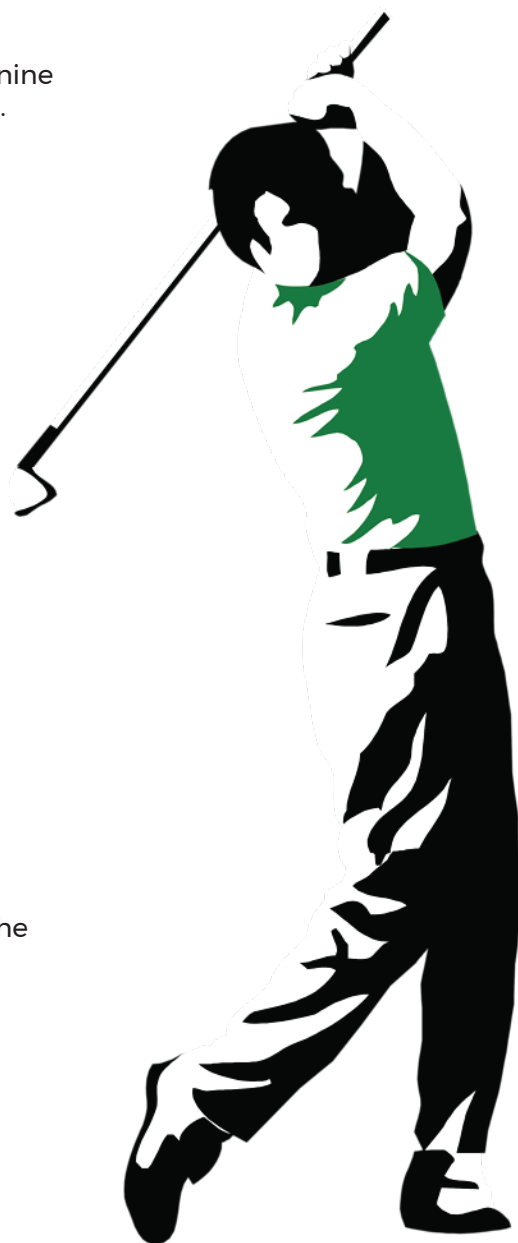
