There were 26 6th grade boys tested. 46.2% of these boys were in the healthy/underweight categor range, leaving 53.8% in the overweight/obese category range. There were 27 6th grade girls tested.59.3% of these girls were in the healthy/underweight category range, leaving 40.7% in the overweight/obese category range. There were 26 8th grade boys tested. 61.5% of these boys were in the healthy/underweight category range, leaving 38.5 & in the overweight/obese category range. The were 21 8th grade girls tested, 52.4% of these girls were in the healthy/underweight category range leaving 47.6% in the overweight/obese range.
