To be eligible for articulated credit a student must:

- Earn at least a "C" in the high school course
- Enroll at ASUMH within 18 months of graduation
- Successfully complete 12 credit hours at ASUMH



Articulated credit is free and can be applied toward non-transferable degrees and certificates.
