FRAN COULTER HONORS PROGRAM REQUIREMENTS & INFORMATION

1. Students must be enrolled full-time (12 hours minimum) at ASUMH and be pursuing an Associate's Degree (Associate of Arts, Associate of General Studies, Associate of Applied Science (any field), Associate of Science in Education, Associate of Science in Criminal Justice, Associate of Science in Agricultural & Natural Resources or Associate of Science in Business).
2. Students must have an ACT of 25 or higher or an equivalent SAT or COMPASS score **or** a gpa of 3.5+ at ASUMH.
3. Students must submit a handwritten essay of 300-500 words on the topic: "Why I want to be part of the Fran Coulter Honors Program."
4. Students must include three letters of recommendation that focus on the student's potential as an honors program participant. Alternatively, letters of recommendation may be emailed to rbaird@asumh.edu from the recommending party.
5. Applications should be received no later than four weeks prior to the first day of classes of the fall or spring semester. (Exceptions may be made on a case-by-case basis).
6. Students must receive a grade of "B" or better in all honors courses – one semester probation allowed-- and must maintain an overall 3.25 GPA to remain in the program – one semester probation allowed.
7. To graduate with Honors recognition from the Fran Coulter Honors Program, a student must have completed at least three approved credit courses, general education or program specific, with a directed honors component **and** the two honors forums (PHIL 1203 and PHIL 2203).
8. Decisions regarding applications will be reviewed by the Fran Coulter Honors Program Director, and exceptions will be reviewed by the ad hoc Fran Coulter Honors Committee
