MY ADMISSIONS CHECKLIST

☐ 1 - Completed ASUMH application online at ASUMH.edu (paper applications are available).

☐ 2 - Official high school transcript in a sealed envelope from the institution or GED scores unless you have completed 24 or more college credit hours.

☐ 3 - If you have any credits from other colleges, an official transcript must be sent directly from all colleges attended.

☐ 4 - Placement scores (ACT, ASSET, SAT, or ACCUPLACER).

- Placement scores may not be required if you have completed College Composition I and/or College Algebra with a "C" or better.

- ACCUPLACER tests are given on the ASUMH campus at a cost of \$20.00.
- To schedule an appointment:

1- Go to www.asumh.edu/testing or call (870) 508-6209

2- Schedule a desired time for appointment

3- Pay the \$20.00 fee with the Cashier

☐ 5 - Immunization record documenting 2 MMR shots (measles, mumps, and rubella). Options if no proof of MMRs exists:

- Vaccinations may be received at the Baxter County Health Unit
- Titer Test may be taken to test immunity
- Exemptions may be applied for from AR Department of Health

What Are My Scholarship Options?

More than 85% of students at ASUMH receive scholarships or financial aid. The Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid works closely with incoming and current students to help fund and achieve their educational goals. The counselors are here to guide you through the financial aid process and to help you take advantage of all the great opportunities to help pay for school.



FEDERAL

Federal Financial Aid includes Pell Grants, Work Study and Veteran and Active Duty Assistance. Your first step is to complete and submit the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) online at fafsa.ed.gov. ASUMH's financial aid school code is **042544**.

STATE

Arkansas offers many opportunities to apply for scholarships and aid to help pay for college. Arkansas students need to complete the Academic Challenge Scholarship (lottery) application at scholarships.adhe.edu. There are also the Career Pathways, ARFuture Grant, Workforce Challenge, Governor's Distinguished Scholarship and more.

LOCAL

Local scholarships are plentiful, and while most are competitive, many are program-specific. The ASUMH General Scholarship Application is available at asumh.edu/scholarship and covers more than 20 of our institutional scholarships. The Promise Scholarship is provided through the Mountain Home Education Foundation for MHHS graduates, and information is available on the MHEF website at <https://www.mountainhomeeducationfoundation.com>.

SAVE MONEY AND GET FINANCIAL AID

The goal of the Office of Scholarships and Financial Aid is to help finance your Arkansas State University – Mountain Home education. We offer assistance to anyone applying for grant and scholarship funding from a variety of sources. Students should complete the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) at fafsa.gov using school code **042544** to apply for grants from the Federal government. Arkansas residents may apply for grants and scholarships from the State of Arkansas at scholarships.adhe.edu between October 1st and June 1st each year.
