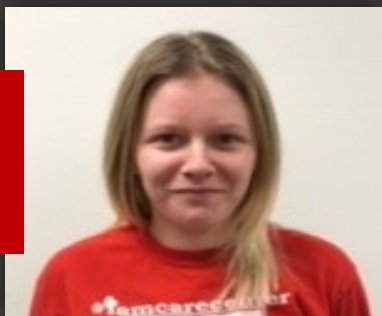

Crissy's Story

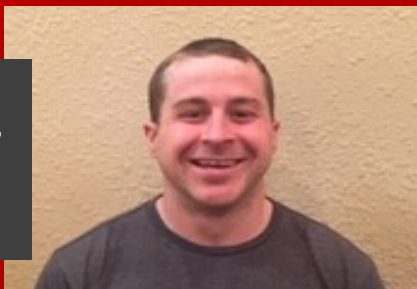


My name is Crissy, and I've been a resident of the Care Center Women's Home for six months. When I came here last September, I had finally come to the end of myself. I was lost, broken, and desperate for hope. Prior to coming to Care Center, my life had been filled with partying, drugs, drinking, and men. I had attempted to drown out the pain of losing my son and other past hurts, and instead I found myself drowning in my addictions. I spent years jumping from one horrible relationship to the next searching for a love that I now know can only be found in Jesus.

Along with destroying anything good in my own life, my sinful and selfish choices also wreaked havoc

upon those closest to me. My nine year old daughter had been especially hurt as the result of my continually bad decisions. But, God is so good. In His infinite goodness He saved me out of all that darkness and healed me. He's restoring me piece by piece. My daughter is now blessed with a godly mother and generational curses are being broken off of her. The difference my family sees in me is encouraging them to know Jesus as well. That old creature is dead, and they're proud of the woman God has made me to be today. Jesus broke my chains and set me free, and I will spend the rest of my life praising Him for it!!! I thank God every day for his mercy and for CareCenter!

"My name is Corbin. I came to CareCenter last July after going through a divorce, which was one of the most draining experiences of my life. I began to pick up old sins and became broken and defeated. I spoke with Pastor Ty on the phone and told him about what I was going through and he prayed with me. I asked God for confirmation on coming to the program and He gave it to me. In the 6 months that I have been here, I have found healing and the renewal of my mind. I have truly

begun to understand what it is to follow Christ and I genuinely have true faith and trust in Him. He is showing me more and more every day who I am in Him and what He has for me in the future. I plan on attending ISOM after I graduate to pursue ministry. God put a calling on my heart back in 2016 and I was running from Him. It's a lot easier to run towards Him!
