TO QUALIFY

Applicants must:

- be a resident of Arkansas
- be a parent or guardian of a child under the age of 21, and the child must live in the home
- have an annual household income below 250% of the poverty level (see chart)
- be pursuing a certificate or degree that will lead directly to employment

In addition, applicants cannot be in default of a student loan and cannot have a felony conviction involving the manufacture or distribution of a controlled substance.



YOUR PATH TO A BRIGHTER FUTURE

ASSISTANCE OFFERED

Individuals receive:

- tuition/fees/book assistance (after Pell funds have been exhausted)
- testing fees
- transportation assistance through gas cards
- childcare assistance
- supplies
- computer lab/free printing
- laptop loan program
- calculator loan program

Students may be required to complete the WorkKeys Assessment and/or obtain an Employability Certificate in order to receive assistance.
