SWIMMING POOL POLICIES

1. There shall be "NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY". Each and every MEMBER and any GUEST will be swimming at their own risk.
2. During certain hours there may be an ATTENDANT at the pool to monitor compliance with pool regulations. This ATTENDANT is not a lifeguard.
3. During certain hours there may be a SERVER at the pool. This server is not a lifeguard.
4. The health department states that any person with infection, communicable disease, etc. is PROHIBITED from using the pool.
5. Personal audio systems are PERMITTED, but are to be used only with individual earphones.
6. All alcoholic beverages MUST be purchased from Big Creek Golf & Country Club.
7. All food and non-alcoholic beverages MUST be purchased from Big Creek Golf & Country Club with the exception being Sunday and Monday afternoons after the kitchen is closed for the day.
8. Glass containers, breakable items and chewing gum are NOT PERMITTED.
9. Swimming suits are REQUIRED at all times while in the pool. Cut-off shorts & other forms of street clothes are NOT acceptable attire.
10. DIVING IS PROHIBITED!
11. Running or boisterous behavior is NOT PERMITTED.
12. If lightning is observed in the local area MEMBERS and GUESTS should leave the pool area. As a precautionary measure the Big Creek staff may close the pool until acceptable conditions return.
13. Official club events take priority over recreational usage of the pool area.
14. Members will be charged a \$5 per visitor per day guest fee for any and all guests. This fee is subject to change without notice. A MEMBER must accompany all GUESTS (any exceptions require approval from the General Manager).
15. MEMBERS' children and/or GUESTS less than seventeen (17) years of age must be accompanied by an ADULT MEMBER.
16. Members may be limited to two (2) guests per member due to capacity restraints at certain times or for certain Club events at the Club's discretion.
17. Children not yet toilet trained and/or in diapers are required to wear "SWIMMER" type swimming pants (NO DIAPERS IN THE POOL).
18. Small toys are PERMITTED providing they are not used in a disruptive or dangerous manner.
19. Strollers, baby carriers and other items of this nature must be kept at least ten (10) feet from the edge of the pool.
20. Children over the age of six (6) are not allowed in the restrooms of the opposite sex.
21. Stair rails and other devices are to guide and assist pool users and are not designed to hold a person's body weight. These should be used only for their intended purposes.
22. All MEMBERS and GUESTS must wear proper attire while in the clubhouse (shoes, shirt, and shorts). Any person(s) not wearing proper attire will be asked to exit the clubhouse.
23. Pets are NOT PERMITTED at any time.
24. Areas of the pool may be reserved for private parties or functions by MEMBERS or by the general public in a similar manner as other clubhouse spaces at the Club's sole discretion. The pool will not generally be entirely reserved to the exclusion of other members though. There may be usage fees and/or food minimums required (the General Manager will set Fees).
25. It is everyone's responsibility to adhere to these rules. If a violation is noted, please notify the General Manager. The General Manager may override or change any rules contained herein.
26. Any person failing to abide by the stated policy or safety rules as stated herein and/or posted will be asked to leave the pool area. Numerous violations and/or serious violations may result in loss of pool privileges and /or membership suspension.
