 1.	Completed ASUMH application found online at ASUMH.edu (paper applications are available).
 2.	Official high school transcript, <i>in a sealed envelope</i> , from the institution or GED scores, unless you have completed 24 or more college credit hours.
 3.	If you have attended any other colleges or universities, official transcripts from <u>ALL</u> colleges attended are required. Official transcripts must be sent <i>directly</i> to the ASUMH Admission Office.
4.	 Placement scores (ACT, ASSET, COMPASS, SAT, or ACCUPLACER). If student has completed College Composition I and/or College Algebra with a "C" or better, placement scores may not be required. ACCUPLACER tests are given on the ASUMH campus at a cost of \$20.00. To schedule an appointment: Go to cutt.ly/asumh-testing or call (870) 508-6209 Schedule a desired time for appointment Pay the \$20.00 fee with the Cashier (3rd floor Roller Hall) If you have any questions, please call MaryJo Haworth in the Testing Center at 870-508-6209. The Testing Center is open Tuesday through Thursday, 8 AM to 5 PM (closed 12:15 PM – 1:15 PM for lunch) and open Friday 8 AM – 12 PM.

Immunization record documenting 2 MMR shots (measles, mumps, and rubella) Options if no proof of MMRs exists: • Vaccinations may be received at the Baxter County Health Unit • Titer Test which tests for immunity, may be performed by your physician • Contact the Arkansas Department of Health to applied for an Exemption
