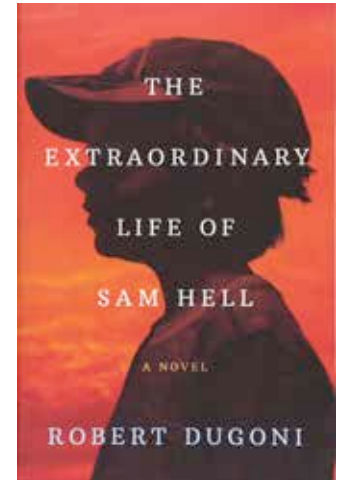

BIG CREEK TO RESUME INITIATION FEES & TO REQUIRE A CLUBHOUSE MEMBERSHIP WITH FUTURE LOT SALES

The Club has had very strong growth in membership and public play over the past two years. As a result, tee times have been a little harder to come by for our members even as we have started to book individual players to fill out existing starting times that have fewer than 4 players.

At the same time, the developers have made the decision to begin requiring at least a Clubhouse membership be maintained by any owner of a lot that they sell in the future. Future buyers can upgrade to Golf membership at their choice, and possibly a new Racquet membership after our planned tennis court rehab is complete. This does not affect lots or homes already sold by the developer.

As a result, both to ensure availability of current tee times and space for future members, we are going to reinstate initiation fees this fall. A date and fee schedule have not yet been set. We have had quite a few new members join recently as word has circulated of this pending change.

Before we began waiving initiation, the fees were:

\$6,000 for Golf;

\$2,500 for Sports, and;

\$1,000 for Clubhouse.

If you are currently a dues-paying member of Big Creek at any level you will not be asked to pay initiation. We are going to use the next few weeks as a grace period for members that have previously resigned, or folks that have been on the fence, to join before the initiation requirement starts back up. The number of new members that join over the next few weeks will determine how quickly we reinstate the initiation so time is of the essence if you or a friend are considering membership.

As a result of this change we plan to limit green fee play in 2022 to resort/hotel guests or visitors to the area from outside our core membership area of Baxter & Marion Counties. We also want to make sure that golfers in surrounding counties know they can join under our non-resident membership which incurs lower dues and do not require food minimums.
