TENNIS / PICKLEBALL COURTS PROJECT



These photos were taken in the rain late yesterday afternoon as the Club is finally undertaking a complete rebuild of our two existing tennis courts. The fencing is being removed for reinstallation at the end of the process.

After extensive studies of multiple options for new courts we have decided to pretty much start over. Our contractor is going to dig an extensive grid of trenches straight into the existing courts and fill them with 4" perforated pipe and base material to address the hydrostatic pressure (underground water) that has caused cracks over the years. After that, he is going to install 4" of new base over the entire surface while also raising the north end slightly to correct the slope to the United States Tennis Association - USTA (Official) specs of 1" in 10' (0.833% to 1% max). After that we get 2" of new asphalt before new net posts and center tie downs are added.



There is a minimum curing period for new asphalt which may push the final part of the project (painting and striping) into spring. We may have some temporary stripes put on the asphalt for play until the painting can be done. And finally, we are planning to install lights and a security entry like we have on the pool gates.

The courts will be striped for two standard tennis courts running north-south as before with 4 pickleball courts striped over them running east-west as well.
