REQUIREMENTS FOR AN ASSOCIATE OF APPLIED SCIENCE IN FUNERAL SCIENCE DEGREE

To earn the Associate of Applied Science in Funeral Science degree, students must meet the following requirements:

2. Have a cumulative grade point average (CGPA) of 2.5 or higher.

MATH 2113

Mathematics for Teachers I

Focuses on sets, logic, and numbers with emphasis on the axiomatic development of the real numbers. For elementary education majors only. Pre-requisite: MATH 1023 or MATH 1043 (not accepted for SPED K-12 and Middle School 4-8 Math/Science) with a grade of “C” or better. This is NOT a methods course. (This course may not be used to satisfy the Associate of Arts or Associate of Applied Science mathematics requirement.) (F)
