Based upon Department of Education and ASU System Guidance, ASUMH is administering a plan to deliver direct-tostudent funds from the Higher Education Emergency Relief Funds III (HEERF III) program which was authorized by the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 that ASUMH has received.

All students enrolled in college level coursework for the Spring 2022 Semester will receive funds using the funding model outlined below and guidance from the American Rescue Plan Act of 2021 passed by Congress and signed into law on Mar. 11, 2021 by the President.

FUNDING MODEL

The amounts delivered were determined based upon a combination of their enrollment level and the Expected Family Contribution (EFC) from the 2021-2022 FAFSA. The tables below describe the amount distributed based upon the enrollment level for Spring 2022 Semester and EFC.
