JUNIOR GOLF IS BACK

The club is excited to announce two separate programs for junior golfers at Big Creek this summer: Junior Golf Camp and Big Creek Junior Academy. Both Camp and Academy are open to all interested juniors regardless of membership in Big Creek. All junior instruction will be supervised by PGA staff members James Stanofski and Mark Morton.

There will be two Junior Golf Camps: June 14-17, and June 21-24. These are for juniors who are interested in beginning golf or have little prior participation in the sport. The camps will have two age ranges: ages 7-11 will meet from 8am - 9:30am; ages 12 & up will meet from 10am - 11:30am. Camp registration is \$75.

JUNIOR GOLF CAMP: JUNE 14 - 17 & JUNE 21 - 24

Campers will learn the basics of the game using SNAG Golf equipment as well as other games and competitions.

- Day 1 Learning basic grip and postures while using SNAG equipment
- Day 2 Continue learning basic grip and posture while enjoying SNAG golf
- Day 3 Putting basics
- Day 4 A fun day of skills challenges learned during the week.

JUNIOR GOLF ACADEMY: TUESDAYS & SATURDAYS FROM APRIL 13 - JULY 27

Big Creek Junior Academy will run for 16 weeks on Tuesdays and Saturdays from April 13 through July 27. Tuesday academy will be in the PM during school and in the AM in the summer. The Academy is for juniors ages 7-17 who would like to learn the game of golf. Limited to a max of 24 players.

Included in Academy:

- Weekly instruction in a class setting
- Scheduled Play Day once a week (9 holes Saturday PM)
- Basic Rules and Etiquette
- Individual Lessons
- Playing 9 holes in 2 hours & 20 minutes or less in a group setting
- Academy shirt and hat

- No cheating
- No damage to the golf course or practice areas

We would like all that are able to play in the Arkansas State Golf Association Chuck Morton Memorial Junior Tournament at Big Creek July 7-8.

TENNIS COURT REBUILD

Some preliminary work has begun on our long-planned tennis court rebuild project. Power has been run and bases constructed for the two sets of exterior LED lights and placeholders put for the two interior poles.

Our main contractor for excavation and asphalt is waiting for an extended dry period to start the excavation work. The current courts will be trenched in a grid pattern with extensive new drainage buried before the entire site is covered with brand new layers of base and asphalt before striping.

The courts will be laser leveled to United States Tennis Association - USTA (Official) specifications, and striped for both tennis and pickleball.


BOOK OF THE MONTH
