





Andrew Huett is competing in the 65th Arkansas Farm Bureau Dairy food contest. The contest takes two winners from each county and then narrows the field to 4 contestants to compete at the state level. Andrew is one of the final 4 competing at the state level with his main dish Buffalo Mac N Cheese. We will be featuring Andrew's dish on Tuesday night in July for \$12.00. We all wish Andrew the best of luck and are cheering for him.

BUFFALO MAC N CHEESE RECIPE:

- 2 Tbsp. butter
- 2 Tbsp. flour
- 1 ½ cup milk
- 2 cups shredded mild cheddar cheese
- 1 tsp. salt
- 4 ½ cups cooked macaroni pasta
- 2 cups shredded sharp cheddar

- 4 cups shredded chicken meat
- ½ cup buffalo sauce
- 2 stalks celery
- 2 Tbsp. ranch dressing
- ¼ cup finely diced red onion
- ¼ cup chopped green onion

Preheat oven to 350 degrees spray 10-inch cast-iron skillet with nonstick spray

Melt butter in a medium saucepan. Add flour and stir until lightly brown. Slowly add the milk stirring constantly until thickened. Remove from heat add the mild cheddar stir till melted. Add the cooked macaroni and stir to coat. Transfer half the macaroni mixture into the prepared skillet top with ½ the sharp cheddar cheese and add the remaining macaroni and top with the last of the sharp cheddar.

In a medium bowl toss the cooked chicken with the buffalo sauce and top with the macaroni mixture.

Bake at 350 for 30 minutes until bubbly. Remove from the oven and let rest.

Using a vegetable peeler make celery ribbons and place them in ice water for 30 minutes to curl. Dice the red onion and garnish the top with red onion celery ribbons and ranch drizzle.
