- \_\_\_ 1. Complete the ASUMH admission application at [www.ASUMH.edu/apply](http://www.ASUMH.edu/apply).
  - An acceptance letter will be sent to once we process the application.
  
- \_\_\_ 2. Placement scores (ACT, ASSET, COMPASS, SAT, or ACCUPLACER) or an unofficial college transcript will be needed in order to register for classes.
  - If you have successfully completed college Composition I and/or College Algebra, placement scores may not be required.
  - If you do not have placement scores that are less than 6 years old, you can take the Accuplacer Next Gen placement exam in the ASUMH Testing Center, located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> floor of Roller Hall. The test will cost \$20.00.

- \_\_\_ 3. Incoming Freshmen (students who have not attended any other higher education institution) will need to submit an official high school transcript or GED scores before the end of their first semester.
  
- \_\_\_ 4. Transfer students (students who have previously attended another higher education institution) will need to submit an official transcript from their most recent undergraduate institution by the end of your first semester.
  
- \_\_\_ 5. All students will need to submit their immunization records with proof of 2 MMR shots (measles, mumps, and rubella) before the end of their first semester.
  - If you are unable to provide proof of these vaccines, you have three options:
    - You can get two doses of the MMR vaccine. Vaccinations may be received at the Baxter County Health Unit.
    - You can get a titer blood test which tests for immunity. See your primary care physician for this test.
    - You can contact the [Arkansas Department of Health](http://www.arkansas.gov/department-of-health) to apply for an exemption
