## TENNIS COURT NEWS/UPDATES





The Club is pleased to announce that Chris Cash is the new Director of Tennis at Big Creek! Chris holds a Master of Tennis - Junior Development certification from the Professional Tennis Registry and will be working with players of all ages/skill levels.

Chris is a co-owner of the Twin Lakes Tennis Club where he already has an established tennis program and teaches. He has won state championships with adults and juniors, trained multiple nationally-ranked juniors, and was awarded the 2014 Arkansas Tennis Professional of the Year from the Arkansas Tennis Association.

The painting and striping (including for Pickle Ball) of the new courts was completed yesterday afternoon, and the courts are secured by padlock to keep everyone off of them for the recommended 7-10 days of curing to avoid scuff marks while fresh. This could change in case of substantial and/or heavy rains. We anticipate that the courts will be ready no later than September 3rd. The courts will be secured by electronic gates using a code like the pool.

We are working with our Club Software vendor to have an electronic sign-up sheet for court time in 90-minute blocks starting either on the hour or half hour. Chris will block out his scheduled events before members have the opportunity to schedule. We are planning to have the reservation system available on a 72-hours-in-advance basis.

We want everyone to get a chance to come see how nice these courts are. They have been built to the exacting USTA standards and have great LED lights as well. Still to be determined is opening times and what time the lights will shut off.



## TENNIS COURT NEWS/UPDATES - CONT'D


Access to tennis will be free for all members during the month of September (aside from events that Chris will charge for) as we get the tennis program started and work out bugs as we find them.

Starting October 1 access to the courts will be by add-on to your Clubhouse or Golf Membership or by individual court usage fees for members looking to play just very occasionally.

- Family Tennis Add On: \$65/month
- Single Tennis Add On: \$45/month
- 17 & Under Add On: \$25/month
- Court Reservation: \$20
- Court Reservation for Golf or Clubhouse Members not paying the monthly tennis add on: ???
- Guest fee: \$10

There will also be classes offered for an additional cost including junior drills, adult drills, and private lessons. We plan to open up the courts over Labor Day Weekend and programming will start Tuesday, September 6th.

We will have an official kickoff/social party Friday, September 9, from 5:30PM - 7:30PM so mark your calendar. We will send out registration information before the event.


