All Big Creek members are welcome to attend our Pickleball Play All as a meet and greet this Thursday evening from 6:00 - 7:30.


This will be a kickoff for pickleball leagues and we want to gauge interest.


NAPA CELLARS CHARDONNAY


The Napa Cellars 2019 Chardonnay displays classic Napa Valley Chardonnay characteristics indicative of this region. Aromas of D'anjou pear, crème fraiche, lemon rind, coconut and soft jasmine floral notes with light, nutty toasted caramel and toffee excite the senses. A soft mouthfeel supports flavors of Fuji apple, pineapple, apricot, kumquat and notes of honeydew melon. A nice, round creamy texture leads into a long finish with refreshing, persistent acidity that pulls together this well balanced, full-bodied Chardonnay. This is the perfect wine to pair with a Camembert French cheese plate drizzled with local honey and almond halves, or with panna cotta topped with fresh berries for dessert.
