TREE REMOVAL HOLE #16

Big Creek Golf & Country Club made the decision to remove a landmark tree next to #16 green yesterday. Here are two before/after photos.

The roots were causing difficulties growing grass in the area. Rainfall also had a strong tendency to drip off the edges of the crown directly into the two bunkers guarding that side of the green. Over the years this has caused these two bunkers to wash out more than normal in heavy rain events and caused the sand to become more quickly contaminated.

Superintendent Brent Edens plans to sod the area w zoysia grass after cleanup is complete. We think this will improve the appearance and playability of this hole in the future.



POSSIBLE FUTURE TREE REMOVAL HOLE #13

The Club is considering the future of another landmark tree - this one that has guarded the left of #13 green since we opened in 2000.

The tree has gotten bigger over the years, making it harder for the average golfer to carry to the back left of this green with enough loft to go over the top.

Superintendent Brent Edens went to trim the tree up this week and reports that one side of the tree doesn't appear very healthy and is starting to drop limbs. He anticipates that sometime in the next five years it will need to come down.

Alternates discussed so far are a replacement tree (maybe planted now, closer to the tee boxes, to give it time to get established and to not eventually interfere as much), or an extension of the bunker there.


