The capstone prepares and develops students' skills for a technical work-stream leader role in their area of discipline within business and technology. Capstone projects will be inquiry and practice-centered and will draw upon areas of interest to the student and focus from the student's major. All capstones aim to bridge theory and practice and are aimed to have an impact on the professional life of students. Students are encouraged to apply and expend knowledge gained through the courses in their selected major as part of this process. An internship can be used to fulfill this course. A minimum of 40 hours of supervised work experience in an approved training situation is required per credit hour awarded.

Julia presented the following:

### **Description of Proposal:**

- #1 Establish a traditional Registered Nursing Program on the ASUMH campus. The program will be a 63 hour AAS Degree program and will meet in a face to face format with classes and clinical Monday through Thursday. All General Education (prerequisites) will be completed prior to entering the RN program.
- #2 Add two new RN classes to the current RN class listing. These classes are introductory courses with basic knowledge and skills for the new nursing student. The new course numbers were approved by Deborah Shaw.
- #3 Change the current RN 6 hour courses to a 4-hour theory course plus a 2- hour clinical course. Each course description has also been updated to correspond with the current class format. All course numbers were approved by Deborah Shaw.

Julia said all this has been sent to the State Board of Nursing for their review at their January meeting. This program is scheduled to start June, 2023. An errata is needed to include the updated course number, and the student success course prefix update, etc. for the catalog.

Tony proposed the following changes in the paramedic degree plan. An errata is needed for the catalog based on this proposal.

## Description of Proposal:

- 1. Change PAR 1214 to PAR 1215 Change the credit hours on the degree plan from 4.5 to 5. The course number change has been discussed and verbally agreed to be accepted.
- 2. Change the credit hours on PAR 2005 from 5.5 to 5 on the degree plan

Sarah made the motion to accept the proposal as presented; Heather seconded. Motion carried.

Dr. Gist stated that a faculty member will be added in the Spring semester for Health Sciences.
