COURSE NEWS & SUMMER UPDATE

Thus far, we've had a fantastic year with the golf course. The greens have really held strong into July. We do have a few thinning areas, but overall, the greens are healthy and smooth. Greens rooting is as strong as we've seen in a few years. With August coming up we are planning on:

- Interseeding greens with Pure Distinction Bentgrass on August 2,3, and 4 (interseeding will create slits in the green that will heal within a day or two).
- Solid tine aerate the greens, weather permitting.
- Topdress greens into late fall.
- Plugging any weak areas.

Our goal is to maintain the grass we currently have on our greens and continue to transition away from L93 bentgrass currently on the playing surfaces.

In other areas, Fairways have really taken off. They became thin in areas from the Fall drought and grub damage along with the severe winter weather. Now, with timely rains and aeration, the fairways are growing and filling in aggressively.

Our staff has done a fantastic job this year, and we appreciate all the compliments we are receiving.
