

## 2023 MATCH PLAY CLUB CHAMPION

Nick Coleman won the 2023 Big Creek Golf & Country Club Men's Match Play club championship by defeating 2021 champ Luke Jackson in 22 holes last Friday afternoon. This was Coleman's 19th year to compete for this title and the first time that he reached the final match.

Nick and Luke entered the back nine w Luke 1UP. Luke missed an 8-foot eagle putt on #10 but tapped in for a birdie. Nick was unable to convert his 5-footer for birdie so Luke went 2UP.

Still trailing by 2 with only three holes to play, Nick birdied the 16th to get one back. After trading bogeys on the tough par-three 17th, Nick forced extra holes with a par on #18.

On the 19th hole (Back on #1), Luke's tee shot got up against the lip of the fairway bunker that forced him to play out sideways. He scrambled and made a tying 15-foot par putt to continue the match. Luke then hit it in the water on the 20th hole (the par-5 #2), but still tied the hole was scrambling par as Nick missed a 12-footer for birdie.

Luke had a 10-foot birdie putt on the 21st hole (#3) to win the match that just missed.

That brought the match to the 22nd hole (#4) where Nick had a lengthy birdie putt similar to the one he had faced in regulation. With his extended family (wife Leah and kids, parents Debbie and Mel Coleman) watching him compete together for the first time since his competitive college days at William Woods University, Nick stepped up to the putt right after his son Jack encouraged him "You got this. You know what this putt does." Nick says he was "lucky enough to make it for birdie and win the match."

Nick also thanked the large gallery of members who followed the match. "It was so hot and zero breeze so it was easy to lose focus. The crowd was amazing. So many people followed along in that heat cheering both of us on. It was really cool to see."

## **COURSE UPDATES**

Superintendent Brent Edens and his staff completed the installation of new Tahoma 31 collars around the par-four seventh green on August 21.







Superintendent Brent Edens and his staff were busy August 21 with an expansion project of our chipping green at Big Creek Golf & Country Club. Earlier this year he opened up new areas on the south side of the practice bunker while the original chipping green was used to experiment w some different varieties of bent grass.

He mowed the existing bermuda/zoysia mix to green height to stunt it and then oversewed 100% w the Pure Distinction bent grass variety, which is one of the varieties we have been inter-seeding into our original L93 bent grass greens. He has mowed a much larger addition on to the south side since the initial project has gone so well. Brent is going to tie the two existing greens together in a horseshoe shape around the bunker as an experiment.

Brent has also informed me that he is having to keep the greens overall on the slow side this week as we deal with five straight days of 100°+ weather. He is very pleased with the grass on the greens after our inter-seeding (ongoing), and he is predicting good things to come as we approach cooler weather in the fall.

#### SODDING GRASS HEADS UP:

On the golf course, we will be sodding Tahoma 31 Bermuda grass around a few of the greens that have yet to have the collars sodded. We will start with 7 green, then 14, then the Chipping green. Our plan for the chipping green is to expand the green we added in front of the bunker, and to unite the two with Tahoma sod and/or bentgrass to create a "Horseshoe green". We are still debating on the best way to preserve our collars for winter. The best option may be to cover the collars for the months of December, January, and February. Unfortunately, there's no great option to protect our collars during winter, but we will do the best we can.

## NEW ARDOT HWY SIGNS FOR ARKANSAS GOLF TRAIL

You may have noticed new Arkansas Golf Trail directional signs for Big Creek Golf & Country Club. The old green signs on US HWY 62/412 on either side of our entrance as well as the old green sign on the Hwy 62/412 bypass near the Harps Food Stores location have all been replaced with new brown signs. The old signs' lettering was deteriorating, necessitating the replacement.

The first picture on the bypass w Big Creek's Managing Partner Lang Zimmerman is from June 3, 2005, when the trail was newish. The second photo, taken May 26, 2023, of the same sign shows how much the lettering had deteriorated. The third photo shows the new brown sign and was taken at same spot on the bypass this week.

The trail was originally called the Natural State Golf Trail when it opened on July 13, 2004.
