- Tabled items from 11/23
  - Proposal to change the maximum number of credits that can be earned via various Prior Learning Assessment methods. Currently, ASUMH has a limit of 15 credit hours. In reviewing the policies of other system and regional campuses, the limit is:
    - No more than 50% of the credits for a credentialed program may be earned from prior learning assessment methods, up to 30 hours total.
    - Request the changes be made to page 49 and page 61 in the catalog to reflect this proposal. If there are places in the catalog I did not find, I request the information also be updated in those places.
    - Note about page 61: This change is so that the language for an Associate Degree matches the language used for the technical certificate and the certificate of proficiency found on page 62.
  - Technical Certificate Pre-Nursing. Remove the prerequisite BIOL and include ORT1031 - First Year Experience for Health Science, and remove OR to requiring Computer Essentials and Math.
