

## **CLUBHOUSE ATTIRE & GENERAL RULES**

The clubhouse and dining room require casual dress including but not limited to golf and tennis attire. Sport coats are acceptable but not required. Unripped jeans and other tasteful denim are permitted. Gentlemen may wear collared shirts casually and untucked. Ladies may wear cocktail attire provided that it is conservatively cut and fit for a family atmosphere where children may be present.

Swimwear, sweatpants or camo apparel are not permitted in the dining areas and scrubs are only permitted during lunch hours.

## **General Rules**

- Guests are not permitted to bring any food or beverages of any kind onto Club property.
- 2. Smoking or vaping is not allowed in the clubhouse, patio dining areas near the clubhouse, or pool complex. Smoking is permitted on the northwest patio and the golf course and members/guests are required to properly dispose of any trash.
- 3. As a courtesy to members and other guests, please silence your cell phone while in the clubhouse and on the golf course. Calls should be placed and received on the patio, in the hallway, or foyer.
- 4. The Club adopts a family-friendly atmosphere and culture. However, children are not to be left unattended or unsupervised in the clubhouse at any time with the expectation of Club staff to monitor their presence. Children under the age of 18 are not permitted in the showering area of the men's or women's locker rooms.
