Golf Dress Code & Playing Rules

- The golf dress code applies to any player utilizing the golf course and golf practice areas except the Social Putting Green where appropriate footwear and clubhouse attire is required.
- 2. Denim of any color, swimwear, sports jerseys, cargo, and athleisure wear are not permitted, and pants or shorts must be Bermuda in style with the exception of wind or rain gear.
- 3. Caps must be worn with the brim facing forward.
- 4. Gentlemen must wear golf-appropriate shirts with collars & sleeves (No t-shirts) unless covered with a secondary layer. Shirts are strongly encouraged to be tucked in.
- Appropriate fashion golf tops and bottoms for women are required with conservative tailoring for a family atmosphere.
 Spaghetti string or halter top style sleeveless shirts are not permitted.
- 6. Leggings for women are not permissible unless worn under golf-appropriate skorts or pants.
- 7. All players must wear appropriate golf footwear. Footwear including water shoes or flip-flops is not permitted. Golf shoes must have non-metal spikes.

Golf Etiquette and Playing Rules

- 1. Non-member groups are limited to a maximum of 4 players.
- 2. Guests are not permitted to bring any food or beverages of any kind onto Club property.
- 3. Golf etiquette consists of courtesy and common sense.
- 4. Players should be mindful of other players in front and behind them. The proper pace of play on the course begins with each player's consideration of others.
- 5. Guests are required to fill divots, rake bunkers, and repair ball marks on all greens.
- 6. The Club adheres to "The Rules of Golf" published by the U.S.G.A. and local rules that pertain to this course are located on the back of the scorecard.
