Digital Art Club Proposed Constitution 2024 - 2025

ARTICLE I. Name

Section 1

The name of this organization shall be known as Arkansas State University-Mountain Home Digital Art Club.

ARTICLE II. Objectives:

The objectives of the Digital Art Club shall be to work on creating, teaching, and sharing digital art using various software.

ARTICLE III. Membership

The Digital Art Club shall be comprised of students who are on neither academic nor disciplinary probation, who are admitted students, and who are enrolled in at least 6 hours in degree programs at ASU-Mountain Home. Any students meeting these criteria are welcome to join Digital Art Club. Students in Digital Art Club commit to at least one full semester.

ARTICLE IV Meetings

Section 1

The Digital Art Club shall hold regular meetings which are open for any student to attend. A special meeting may be called Digital Art Club sponsor or by any member of the Digital Art Club.

Section 2

Meeting times and dates shall be determined at the beginning of each semester by a popular vote of the Digital Art Club. The meetings shall coincide with the schedule of the sponsor.

Section 3

A quorum will consist of two-thirds (2/3) representation of the membership of the Digital Art Club.

ARTICLE V Officers and Duties

Section 1

All executive powers of the Arkansas State University-Mountain Home Digital Art Club shall be vested in Digital Art Club Executive Board.

Section 2

The Digital Art Club Executive Board shall consist of:

- A. The Digital Art Club sponsor
- B. President of Digital Art Club
- C. Vice President of Digital Art Club
- D. Secretary of Digital Art Club

Section 3

Offices to be filled by election from within the Digital Art Club include:

- A. President of Digital Art Club
- B. Vice President of Digital Art Club
- C. Secretary of Digital Art Club

ARTICLE VI Candidacy of Officers

Section 1

Qualifications:

All candidates must meet membership qualifications (Article III) and be eligible to serve one full semester.

- A. A candidate for President of the Digital Art Club shall have been active in Digital Art Club for one (1) semester immediately preceding his/her term of office.
- B. A candidate for President must have completed twelve (12) credit hours before his/her term of office begins and must have a 2.5 or higher grade point average.
- C. A candidate for President of Digital Art Club shall not hold the office of President in any other organization.
- D. A candidate for Vice President shall have been enrolled for at least one (1) semester at ASU-Mountain Home immediately preceding his/her term of office. A candidate must have completed twelve (12) credit hours before his/her term of office begins and must have a 2.5 or higher grade point average.
- E. A candidate for Secretary must have a 2.5 or higher grade point average or, if an entering freshman, be full-time student enrolled in a degree program at ASU-Mountain Home.

ARTICLE VII Election of Officers

Section 1

The officers of the Digital Art Club shall serve a term of one academic year from their election in the fall semester to the end of the spring semester. An exception will be made for students who are completing their degree at the end of the Fall semester.

- A. Election for the offices of President, Vice President, and Secretary will be held at the September meeting of the Digital Art Club.
- B. Election of officers shall be decided by majority of the votes cast by the membership of the Digital Art Club.
- C. The Digital Art Club sponsor shall monitor and conduct all elections.
