Old Business

Student Club Proposal – anticipated a submission for a Computer Club sponsored by Karl Mudra, however is hasn't been received yet so no action has been taken.

Workgroup Reports

Retention Workgroup – VBeck reported the group has not been able to meet since November. Our retention from Fall semester to Spring was very encouraging.

Ad Hoc Student Handbook Workgroup – group set to meet in February, Aly Bramblett will head the effort.

Student Activities Manual Workgroup – no report, although it was agreed there is a need to understand things such as how to spend money made available to clubs.

New Business

AI Ad Hoc Workgroup report – Jessica Clanton spoke to the committee with a proposed addition to the Student Handbook covering students' rights related to accusations of AI use in schoolwork. The proposed language addition follows and would be added to Step I of Procedures for Academic Appeals and Grievances.

“To ensure the ethical and fair use of AI-enhanced grading tools, students have the right to contest AI-detected issues and provide explanations or evidence to support their case through an established feedback mechanism”.

GTruell motioned and NLueck seconded that this receive the Committee's support as it proceeds through the Shared Governance process. Passed.

RBaird gave an overview of the recent student organizations and their activities.

BCarlisle mentioned the Student Handbook will also need a revision to reflect mandated language on “Hazing”
