# Arkansas State University-Mountain Home Student Ambassadors

## **Position Description:**

Membership in the Student Ambassadors organization is based on academic achievement, involvement in extracurricular activities, leadership abilities, and recommendation of faculty and professional staff.

Student Ambassadors represent Arkansas State University-Mountain Home at various functions such as orientations, campus tours, school visits, speaking engagements, clerical duties and other special events. Ambassadors assist in student recruitment and support development efforts. Ambassadors will fill out an application for the program and for ASUMH as they will receive a scholarship.

Student Ambassadors serve as student representatives when welcoming and hosting honored guests and distinguished members of the college community. Ambassadors participate in college activities and represent Arkansas State University-Mountain Home both on and off campus.

#### **Requirements:**

- Students must maintain a 2.75 cumulative grade-point average to remain active. If the ambassador remains in good standing, he/she will be asked to return if he/she wishes to do so for the entire four semesters they are a student.
- An ambassador must meet all of the requirements before receiving the offer.
- A student must be enrolled in at least one (three hour) Arkansas State University-Mountain Home class.
- The student's G.P.A will be reviewed at the end of each semester in order to make sure he/she continues their eligibility for the Ambassador position.

## **Application Process:**

- 1. Obtain a letter of recommendation from a member of the Arkansas State University-Mountain Home faculty and/or staff. High school seniors may obtain a letter from a counselor of instructor within their high school.
- 2. Verify 2.75 cumulative grade-point average and proof of enrollment.
- 3. Complete and submit a Student Ambassadors application form to the Office of Recruiting, (located at the Sheid)

### **Interview/Selection Process:**

- The selection committee will interview prospective Student Ambassadors.
- A maximum of 10 talented and enthusiastic students will be chosen.
