Clean vs. Polluted Environments

Grade Level: K-2

Subject:

Standard: Students will understand the concept of pollution and how it affects the environment.

Students will identify different ways they can help reduce pollution.

Arkansas State Standard: **C.1.K.7** – Identify ways humans impact the environment.

Materials:

Picture book: Dr. Seuss's The Lorax

Chart paper

Markers

Pollution Video

Pollution Quiz

Introduce and Demonstrate Skill/Strategy/Content:

- Begin with a question: "What do you think pollution is?"
- Show pictures and a short video of polluted environments.
- Read a short story "The Lorax" to introduce the concept of pollution.

Review/Independent Practice:

- Have students draw a picture showing a clean environment vs. a polluted environment.
- Ask students to share one way they can help reduce pollution.

Formative/Summative Assessment:

- Formative: Observe student participation in discussions and activities.
- Summative: Assess students' drawings and explanations about pollution and how to reduce it.
