



CONCURRENT COURSES



High school Freshman, Sophomores, Juniors, and Seniors are eligible to take 15 credit hours/semester through the “New” Access to Acceleration Scholarship.



The Access to Acceleration Scholarship offers an incredible opportunity for students by covering tuition up to 15 credit hours/semester. There will be no cost of materials ensuring that students have everything they need to succeed. Students must maintain a GPA of 2.5 or higher to remain eligible for the scholarship.



Students can choose from any of the courses listed on the second page. Some courses are taught at the high school, some are taught entirely online, and some are taught on the ASUMH campus.



To register, students need to meet with their high school counselor or the ASUMH Concurrent Coordinator. An application will be submitted along with placement scores. A minimum 19 ACT Reading score or 252 Reading Accuplacer score is needed for most courses. Math and English placement scores will vary based on the course.
